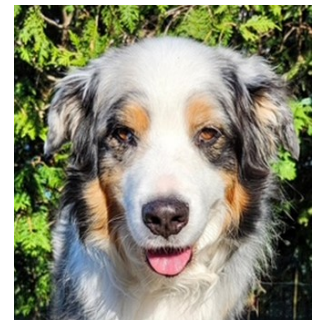
PET THERAPY

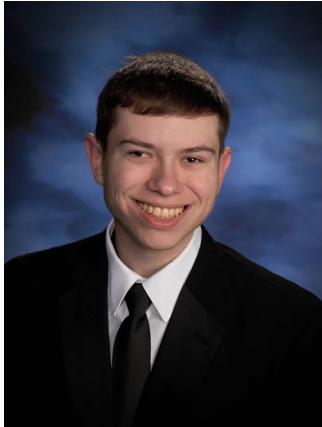
June represents D-Day on June 6th, Women's Veterans' Day on June 12th, Flag Day, June 14th and June 14th is Army's Birthday!

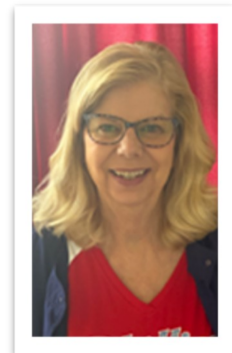


DIRECTIONS: Find and circle the vocabulary words in the grid. Look for them in all directions including backwards and diagonally.
