

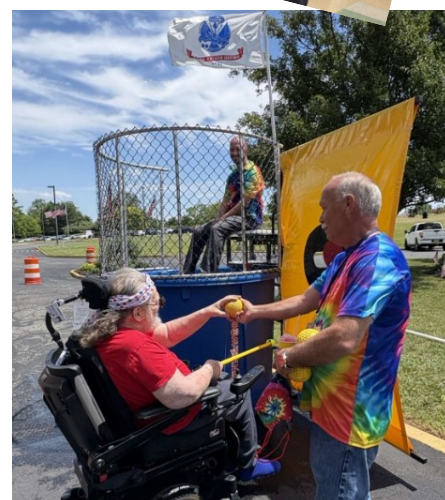
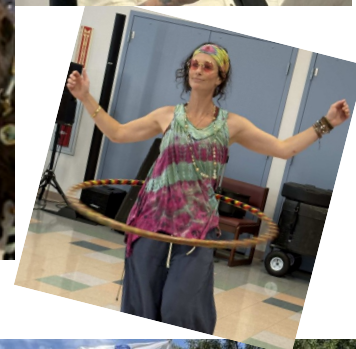

Get motivated and take time to express yourself by designing a creation! Creating art may relax you and become your new hobby!



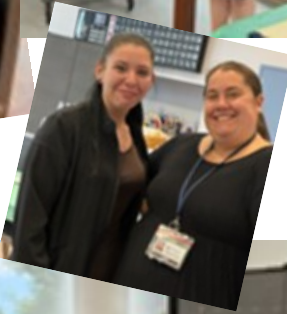
